

This letter contains some important information about a revision to the 2023-2024 school calendar. As many of you may know there will be a Solar Eclipse that is projected to affect the Tri-State area on April 8, 2024. Due to the anticipated large crowds, possible traffic, and timing of the eclipse we have decided to change April 8, 2024 into a Virtual School Day. The eclipse is expected to start around 12:30 and last until after 3:00. Since it is not recommended that people be driving during the eclipse and that this event will be during dismissal time we've decided that a Virtual Day would be the safest option for our students and families.

We very much appreciate your understanding and flexibility. We hope that this event is a great learning experience for our students. The school will be providing the students with the recommended Solar Eclipse Glasses so they can view the eclipse safely from home. 
