

School Lunches

- *USDA has approved free meals for all enrolled students for 2021/2022.
- *Households should still fill out an application if they would like to be eligible for other educational benefits. Some examples of other educational benefits may include curricular (textbook) assistance, test/exam fee reduction or waiver, and eligibility for other discounts or program opportunities.
- *The price for adults/visitors/unenrolled students is \$4.60. This price is set by the USDA.
- *We operate an "offer vs. serve" lunch.
- *Each student is offered at least 5 food components (meat/meal alternate, grain, fruit, vegetable, milk).
- *They may take all that is offered or pick and choose at least 3 items with one being a 1/2 c. fruit or 1/2 c. vegetable.

Lunch Boxes from Home

- *School lunches are free but milk cost is \$.65.
- *Take a milk with a fruit and a vegetable and it counts as a free lunch.
