



SGO SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

State approved non-profit organizations may receive donations from individuals or corporations to help pay for a child's private education. These non-profits are called Scholarship Granting Organizations (SGO) and currently provide scholarships to thousands of Hoosier students throughout the state:

HOW TO APPLY FOR THE SGO SCHOLARSHIP:

- 1) Determine if your student (between the ages of 5-22) is eligible based on income requirements (see table below). Kindergarteners must be 5 years old by August 1st.
- 2) Choose an eligible school that best meets your child's needs.
- 3) Submit the application to your school.
- 4) Submit income verification documents to the school.
