



TUITION ASSISTANCE

St. Philip Catholic School is a participating **Indiana Choice Scholarship provider**. Please see the attached “Frequently Asked Questions” document to answer all of your questions about applying. Once the application window has opened, I will communicate with families that it is time to apply. I will share all of the necessary documents and information needed to begin that process. I will assist all eligible families through the entire process.

St. Philip Catholic School is also associated with the Institute for Quality Education (IQE) to provide a **Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO)**. The SGO amounts will vary and the final amount is determined by the amount of donations received. St. Philip Catholic School must approve all SGO scholarships. Families may go to the Institute for Quality Education online (<http://www.i4ged.org>) to learn more and complete an application. I will facilitate completing the SGO scholarship application online as needed.

The following are guidelines to consider when determining if you are eligible for an SGO:

- Student must live in Indiana
- Student may be eligible in Kindergarten through Grade 12
- Student is currently attending a private school or applying to a private school
- Household annual income is at or below 200% of free and reduced lunch guidelines

If a private school student received a scholarship from a Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO), then the student may be eligible for an Indiana Choice Scholarship from the State for subsequent years at the approved private school. However, the final determination of this is by the School Choice guidelines.

Note: When applying for the **School Choice Scholarship** or the **SGO**, a copy of your previous year’s tax form indicating your adjusted gross income and verification of household size will be necessary.

I have attached the 2020-2021 Income Guidelines for your reference. The FAQ documents are from the 2019-2020 school year but many of the questions addressed will still help answer questions for this coming school year.
