PRESCHOOL/PRE-K AGE REQUIREMENTS:
♦ Child <u>MUST</u> be 4 years old on or before AUGUST 1st and potty-trained for Pre-K
♦ Child <u>MUST</u> be 3 years old on or before AUGUST 1st and potty-trained for Preschool

Children may not wear diapers or pull-ups during class or extended care time.

FACTS TUITION MANAGEMENT

PAYMENT PLANS	St. Philip Catholic School utilizes FACT Tuition Management for families to select and set-up their preferred direct payment plan. During July, you will receive a link from FACTS Tuition Management to establish your account. All balances should be paid in full by May 31, 2022 (10 months).
